

An educational DVD-Rom about the internment camps in the South of France (1939-1944)

2012 – The association “Mémoires: Les Juifs dans la Résistance” and Courte Echelle Prod. present a DVD-Rom entitled, “*Internment camps in the South of France. Between history and memory. 1939-1944*”

This material brings together numerous resources for teachers and students alike. Many different disciplines are involved in this work: History, Civic Education, Documentation, Humanities, Philosophy, Education in the Visual Image, Art, Spanish etc., thereby facilitating interdisciplinarity and cross-curricular competency (transferable skills). The DVD-Rom, as a teaching tool, is suitable for several school age groups: from primary, through secondary up to baccalaureate. It is also intended for the general public in the widest sense and is therefore perfectly suitable for Libraries and Archive Centres.

This box set contains three DVDs including documentaries, sequenced witness accounts, as well as a digital booklet. It also contains a printed notebook showing the arborescence (tree structure) of the three DVDs and also a user manual giving access to various historical and educational documents that can be printed out (stored in the root of the DVDs).

Three documentaries

- *FRENCH CAMPS BY MEMORY* (50 mins)

The camps were set up at the end of the Third Republic for Spanish and German refugees, and under the Vichy Government, became the tools of its xenophobic and anti-Semitic policy, until that fatal turning point in the summer of 1942, when the regime handed over tens of thousands of Jews to the Nazis. Edith Moscovic, Angelita Bettini and Paul Schaffer, witnesses who are thrown into the tumultuous war, tell their story of the dark years of the European tragedy.

- *IN SEARCH OF HISTORY. THE LOST CHILDREN OF BOULOC* (45 mins)

A class of 10-11 year olds (Year 6), guided by their teacher, set out to find what happened to two Jewish children. They appear on a school photo taken at Bouloc School in 1942, but in 1943, they are missing. The children’s class of today set out in search of their story.

- *WRITING PATHS: HISTORY AND TESTIMONIES* (40 mins)

The Nazis considered that a glorious page of their domination would be the fate dealt out to the Jews, because it would never be written. So it is our victory over the “vile beast” that Bertolt Brecht denounced; writings that flow like an endless river. Interviews with Serge Klarsfeld, Patrick Cabanel, Jacques Cantier, Monique Lise Cohen and Denise Epstein.
